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Dear Sirs,

Further to my previous email on this subject, it has been brought my attention by the District Council that the UK Government sea and river flooding perdition for 2050 indicated that Langtoft Village will be at risk (see attached map extract). This is only a decade after your 2041 local plan.

Also, according to a news article broadcast by the BBC recently, there is growing evidence that the number of severe storms resulting in flooding (11 this year alone) is increasing and is predicted to continue to do so. They also reported that the demands on the Environment Agency to maintain rivers and drainage is reaching a level the agency cannot sustain.

I must ask you to consider the practicality of proposing housing expansion on what will eventually be a flood plane.
