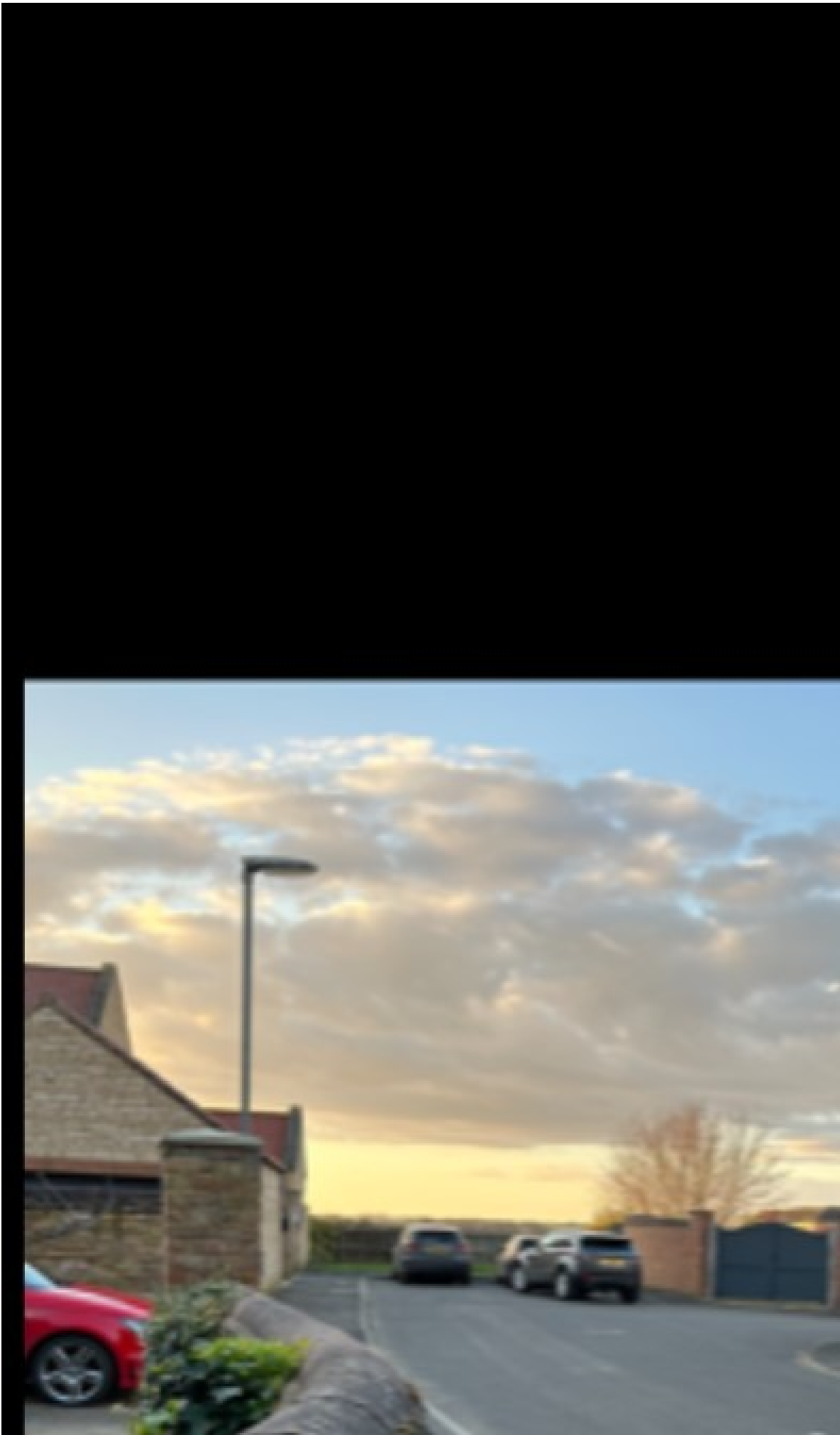
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Additional photos to my objections to site SKPR-71

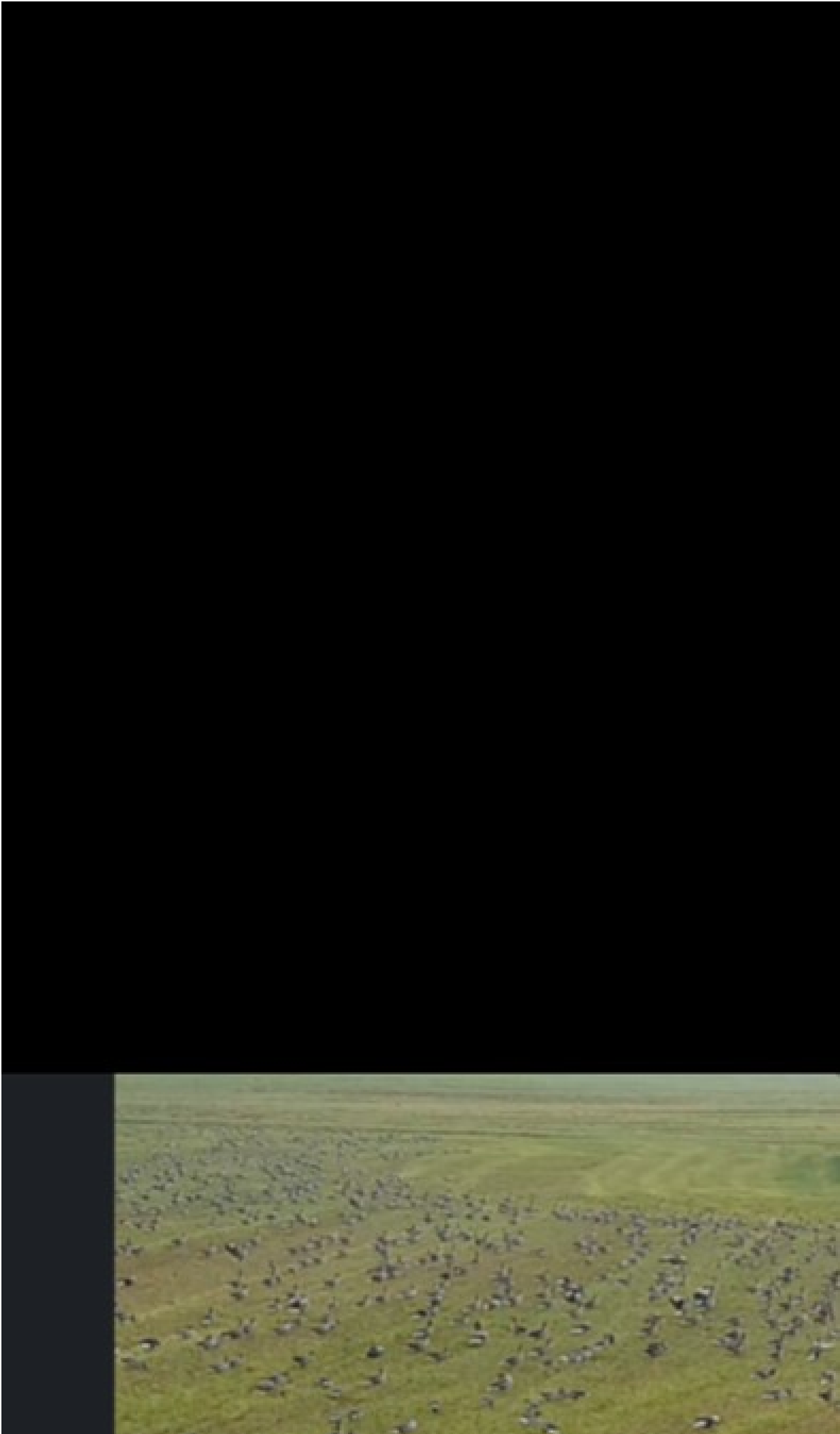

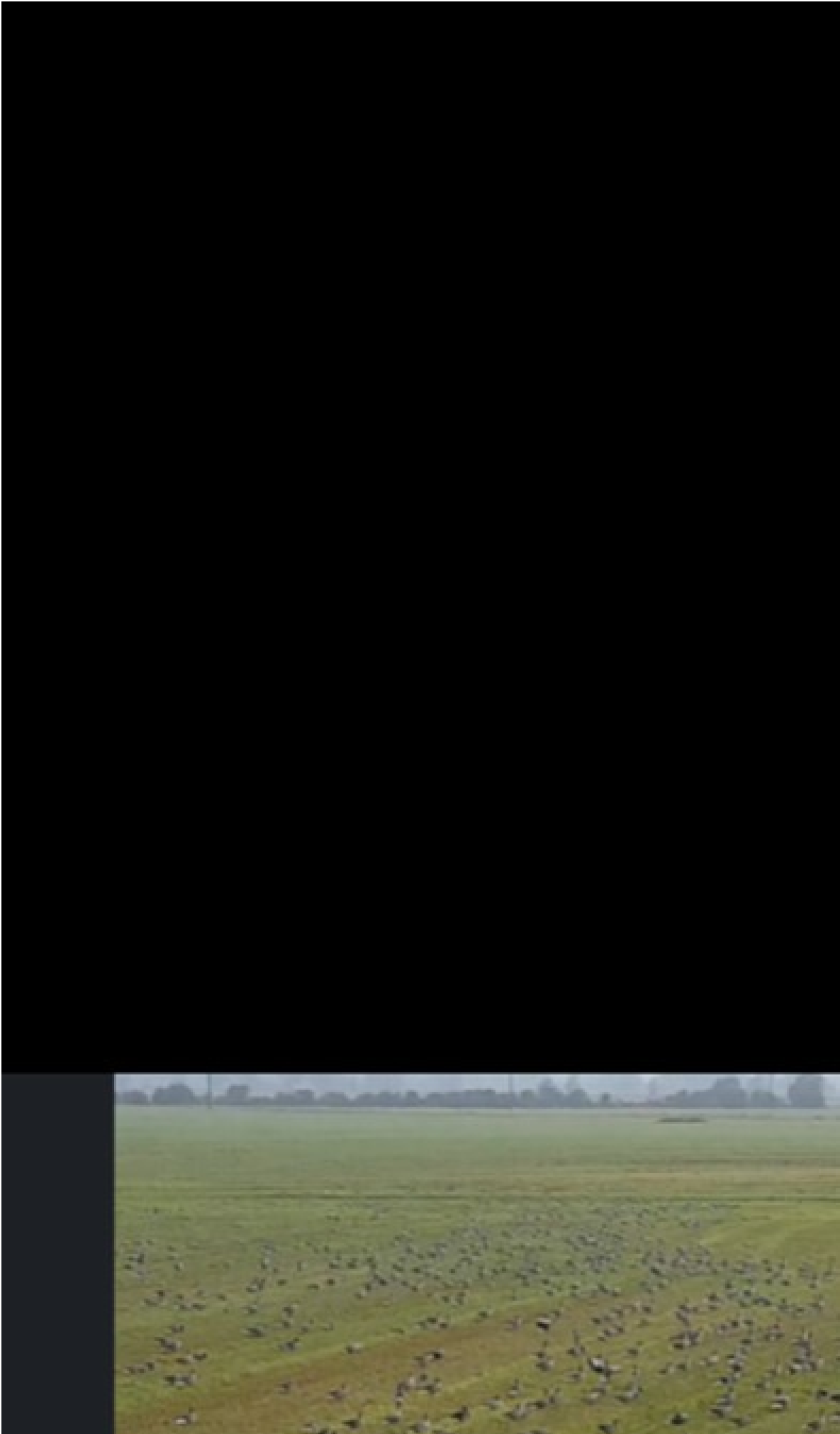
Taken from the Dickens Close / Stowe Road junction - the proposed access point, looking into Dickens Close. Shows that the first driveway from this blind-corner is less than the legally required 10 metres from the junction. Shows also the narrow and busy Close that can not support any additional traffic. Shows also the narrow, grass access point area, straight ahead, between houses 6 and 7, which has been used and maintained by residents of numbers 6 and 7 since its construction in 2006. It has never once in that period been used or maintained by the owner.
